

The Rt. Hon. Sir Conor Burns MP Attachment to letter 02 May 2024 Branksome Triangle Survey Summary

- Of the Bournemouth West respondents who responded to the survey:
 - 94% believed that the Branksome Triangle site was not a suitable location for a 'Settled Traveller and Gypsy Community' site.
 - 98% said that they had not been consulted by BCP Council on the proposed location as a 'Settled Traveller and Gypsy Community' site.
- It is worrying that people do not feel like their voices have been heard. To rectify this, we sent every constituent who filled in the survey a QR code linking to BCP Council's Local Plan consultation.




